SUMMARY

Rwanda ranks 32 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 57%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 45% and a data openness subscore of 68%.

Rwanda scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

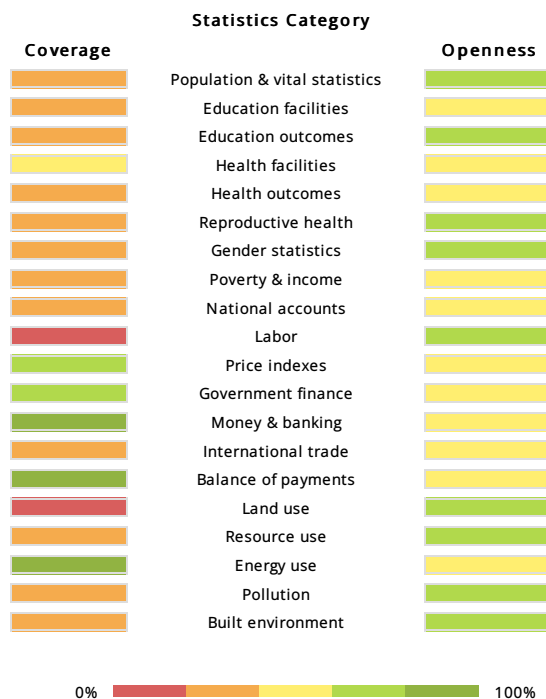
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in social and environmental statistics.

Openness

- Publish more data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Make available download options for all data to allow users to customize data exports.
