SUMMARY

Rwanda ranks 41 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 54%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 44% and a data openness subscore of 63%.

Rwanda scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics
- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.

Openness

- Publish more economic and environmental data in machinereadable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Publish more metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
