SUMMARY

Serbia ranks 39 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 55%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 52% and a data openness subscore of 57%.

Serbia scores higher than the regional median for environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

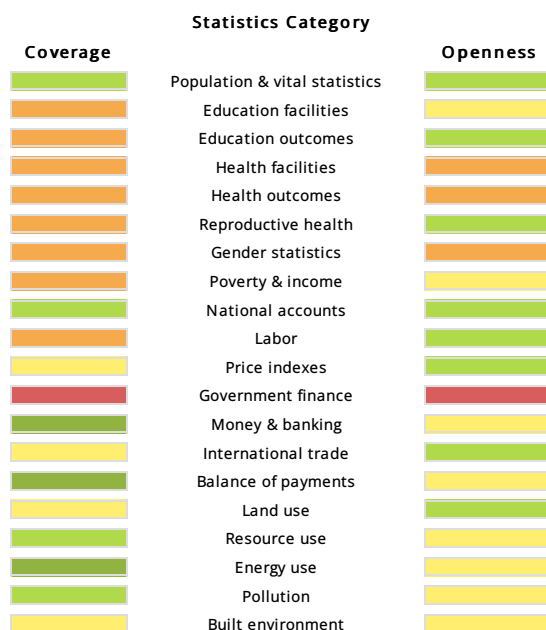
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in social statistics.

Openness

- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Make available download options for all data to allow users to customize data exports.
