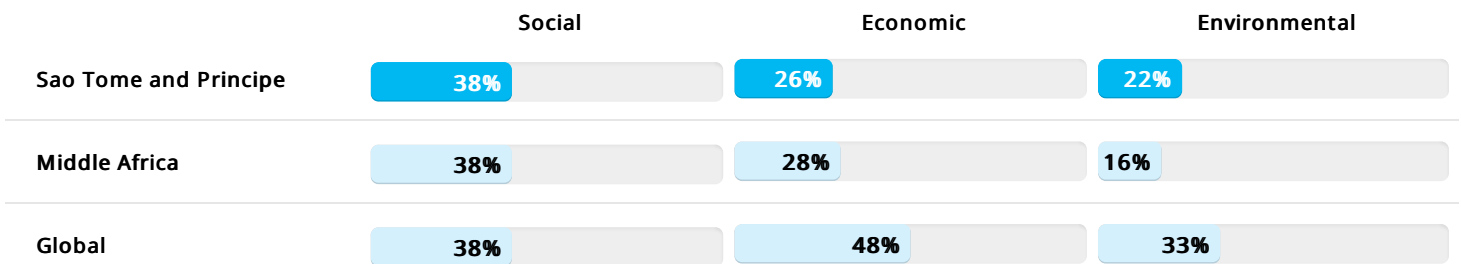

SUMMARY

Sao Tome and Principe ranks 118 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 32%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 24% and a data openness subscore of 37%.

Sao Tome and Principe scores higher than the regional median for social and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

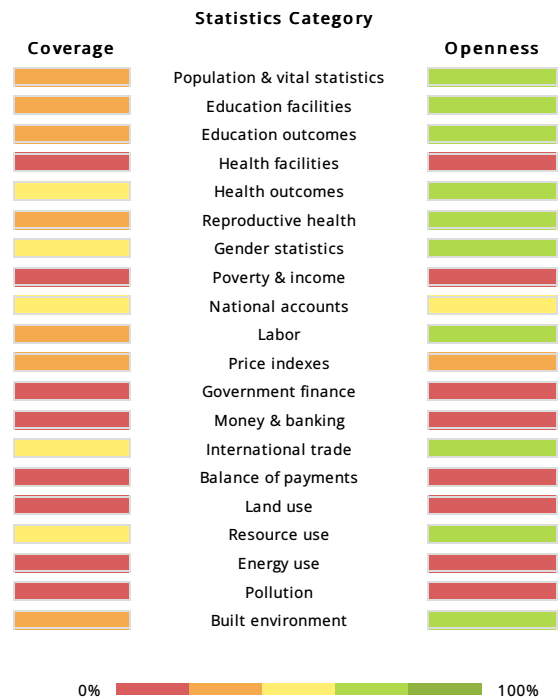
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

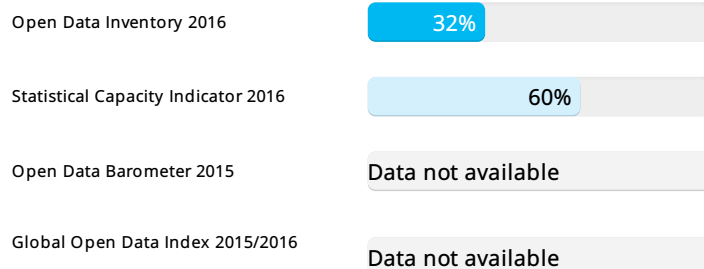
Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more economic and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
