SUMMARY

Sweden ranks 1 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 83%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 73% and a data openness subscore of 91%.

Sweden scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

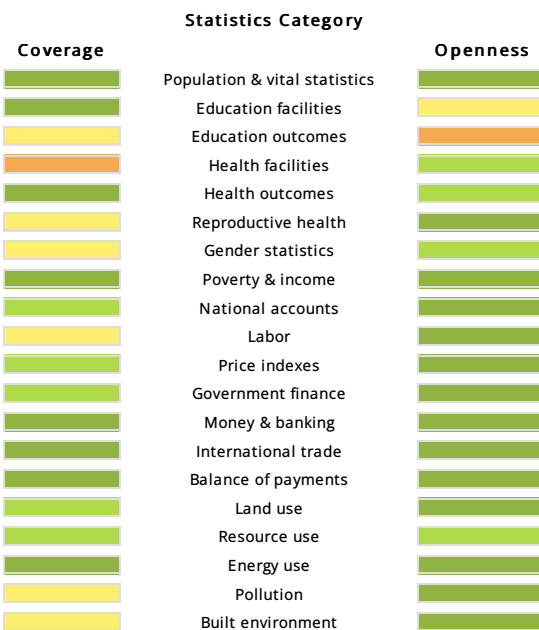
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first and second administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

Openness

- Publish more social data in non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV or JSON.
