SUMMARY

Thailand ranks 91 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 38%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 39% and a data openness subscore of 38%.

Thailand scores higher than the regional median for social and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

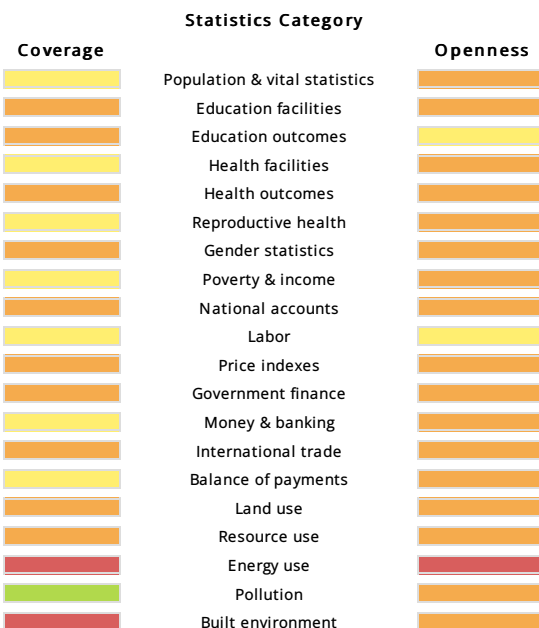
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in economic statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
