SUMMARY

Thailand ranks 119 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 33%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 39% and a data openness subscore of 28%.

Thailand scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in economic and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use policy that does not restrict access, such as CC0 or CC BY.
- Publish more data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
