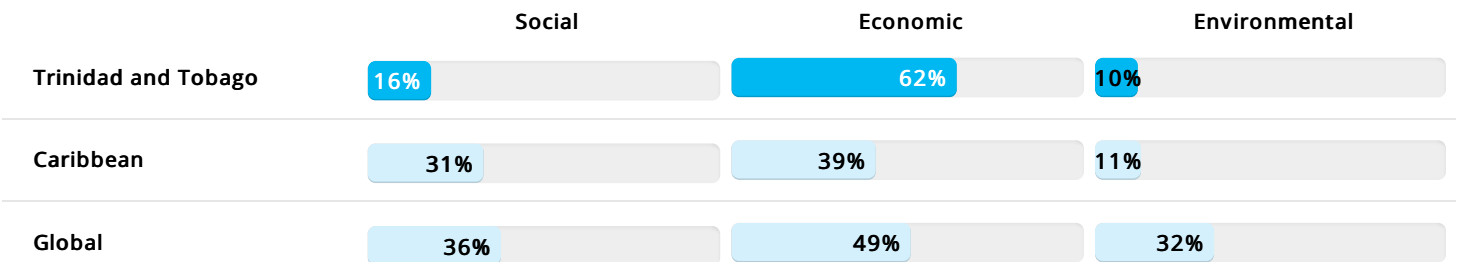

SUMMARY

Trinidad and Tobago ranks 140 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 28%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 20% and a data openness subscore of 36%.

Trinidad and Tobago scores higher than the regional median for economic statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

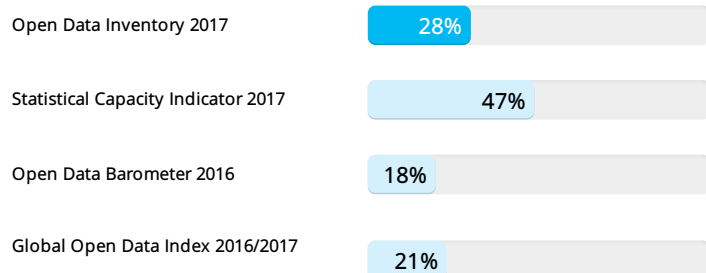
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data that are disaggregated by sex and are relevant to the welfare of women and their children.

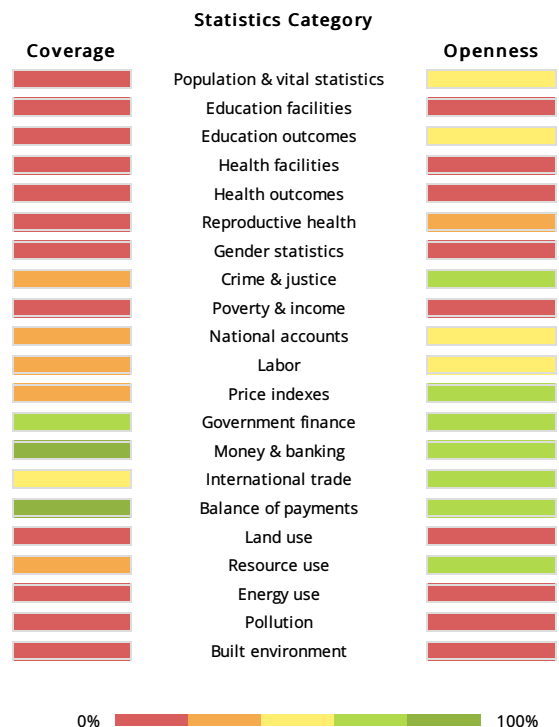
Openness

- Adopt an open terms of use such as CC0 or CC BY for all agencies who publish official statistics.
- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
