SUMMARY

Tanzania ranks 121 in the Open Data Inventory 2017 with an overall score of 33%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 36% and a data openness subscore of 31%.

Tanzania scores higher than the regional median for social and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

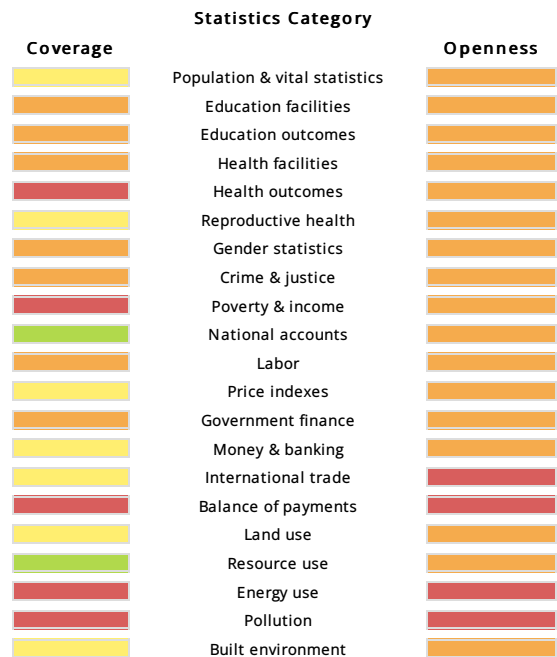
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
