

SUMMARY

Austria ranks 24 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 68%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 61% and a data openness subscore of 74%.

Austria scores higher than the regional median for economic and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social statistics.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- ٠ Make available download options for social data to allow users to customize data exports.
