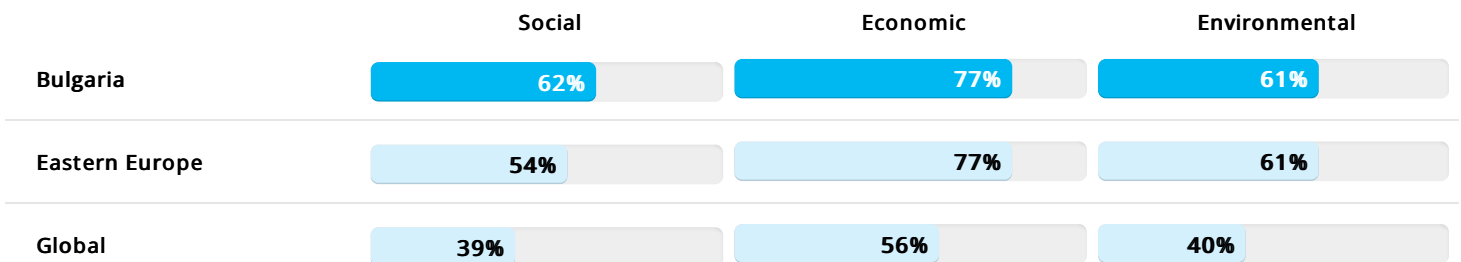

SUMMARY

Bulgaria ranks 25 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 66%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 62% and a data openness subscore of 70%.

Bulgaria scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

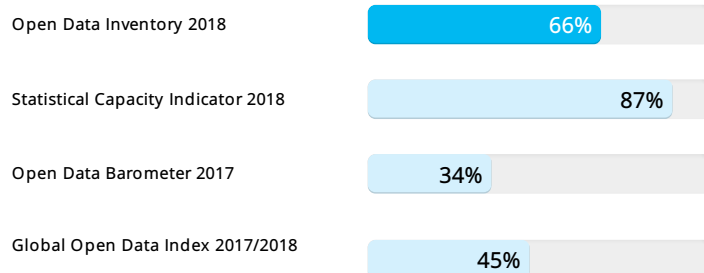
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

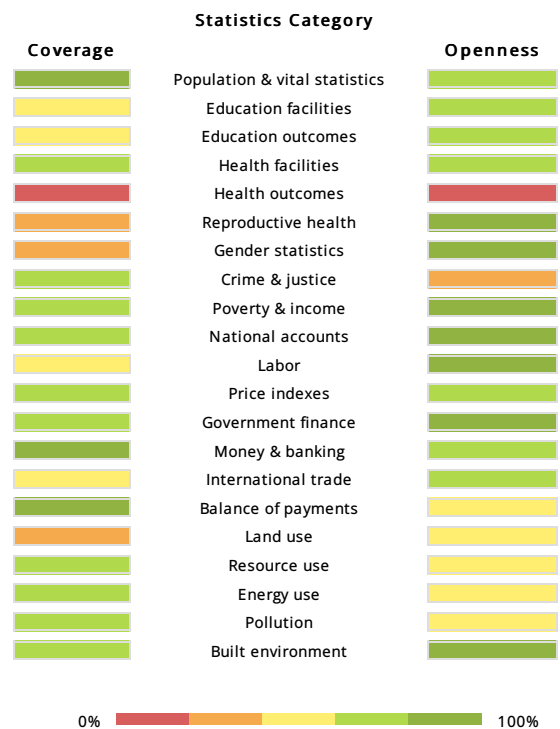
Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more environmental data in non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
