SUMMARY

Colombia ranks 76 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 48%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 50% and a data openness subscore of 46%.

Colombia scores higher than the regional median for economic and environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

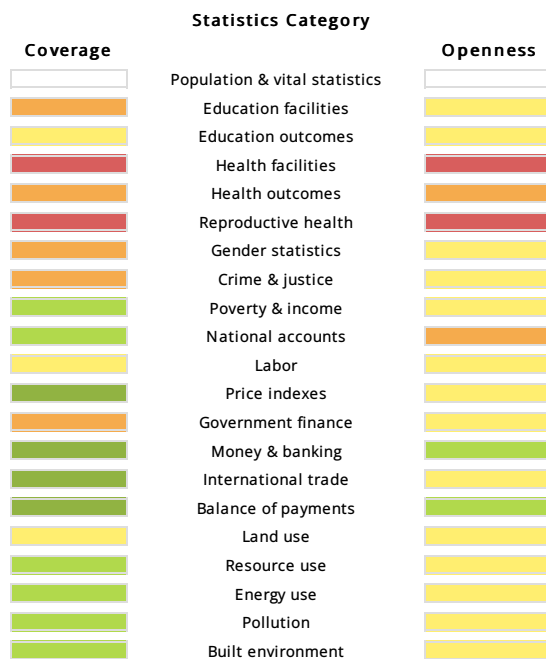
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more social data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
