SUMMARY

Denmark ranks 7 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 78%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 65% and a data openness subscore of 89%.

Denmark scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more historical data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first and second administrative level across all data categories.

Openness

 Make available download options for all data to allow users to customize data exports.
