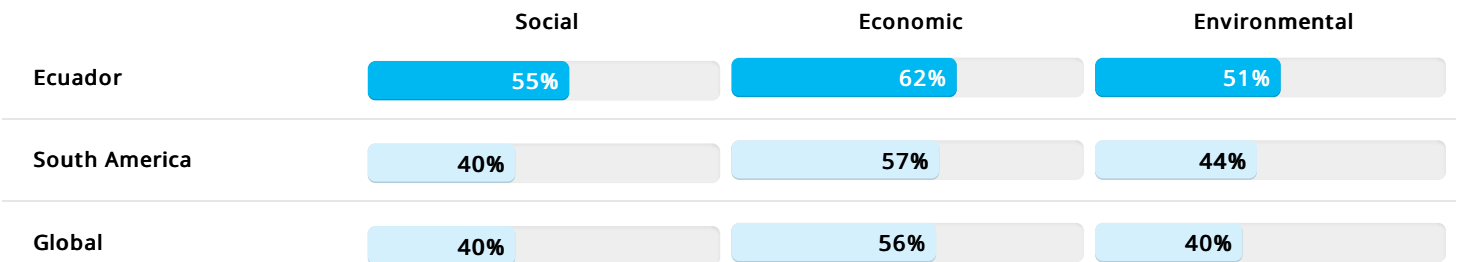

## SUMMARY

Ecuador ranks 50 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 56%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 48% and a data openness subscore of 63%.

Ecuador scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

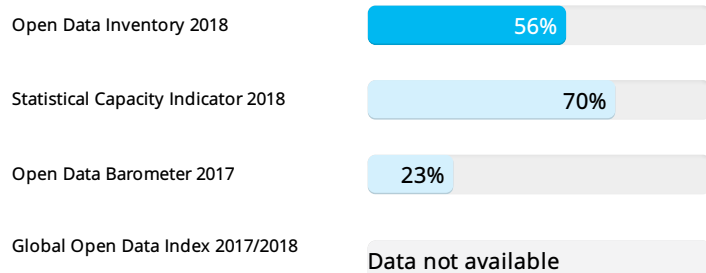
### Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

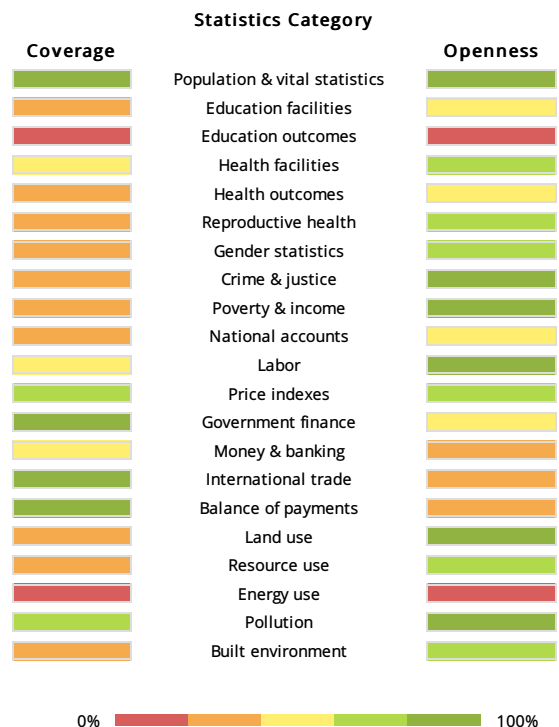
### Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
