SUMMARY

Spain ranks 21 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 69%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 66% and a data openness subscore of 73%.

Spain scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

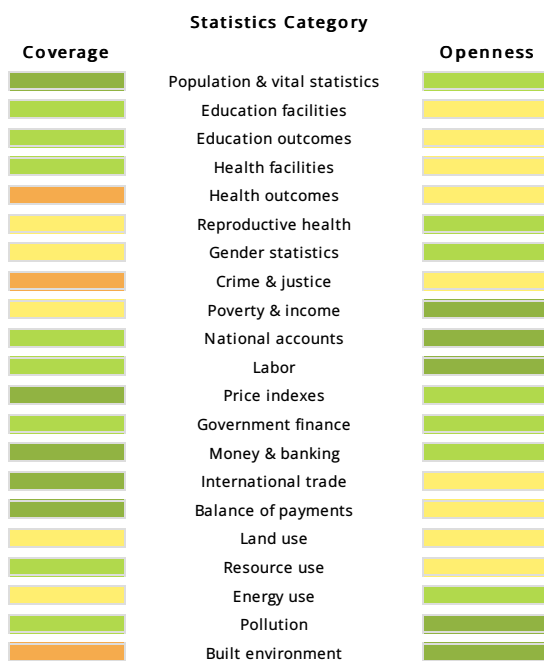
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in environmental statistics.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Make available download options for social data to allow users to customize data exports.
