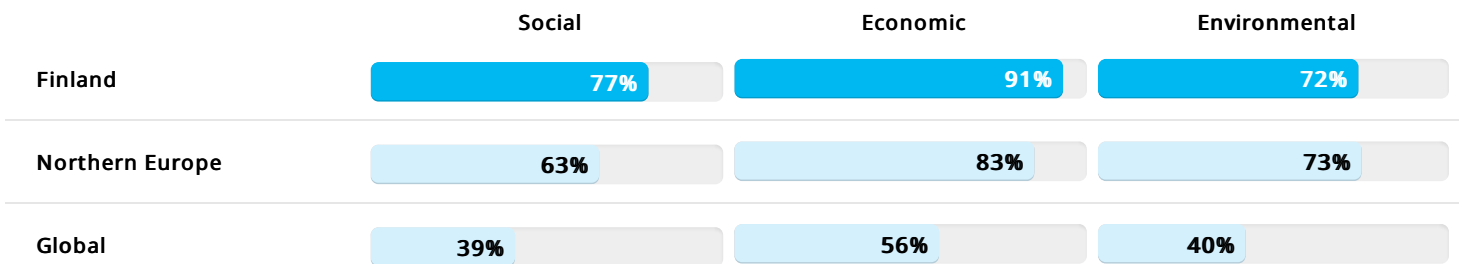

SUMMARY

Finland ranks 6 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 80%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 74% and a data openness subscore of 85%.

Finland scores higher than the regional median for economic and social statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

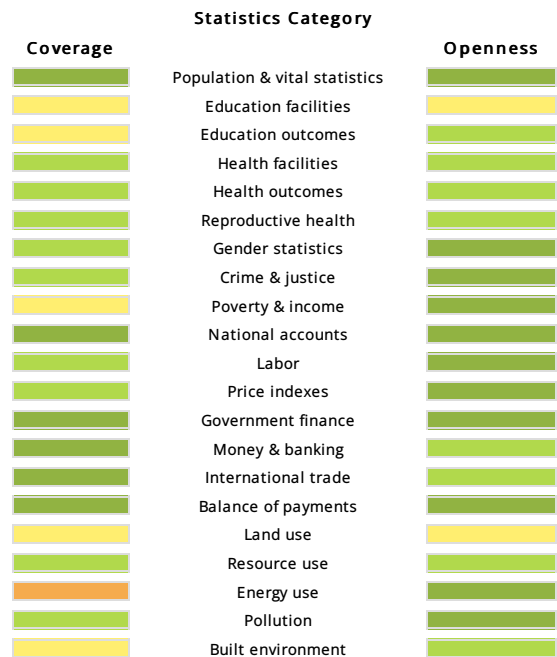
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level across all data categories.

Openness

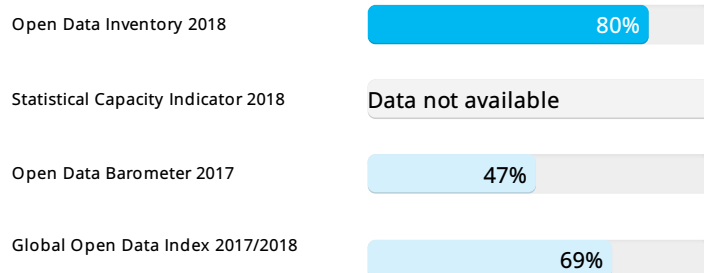
- Make available download options for environmental data to allow users to customize data exports.
