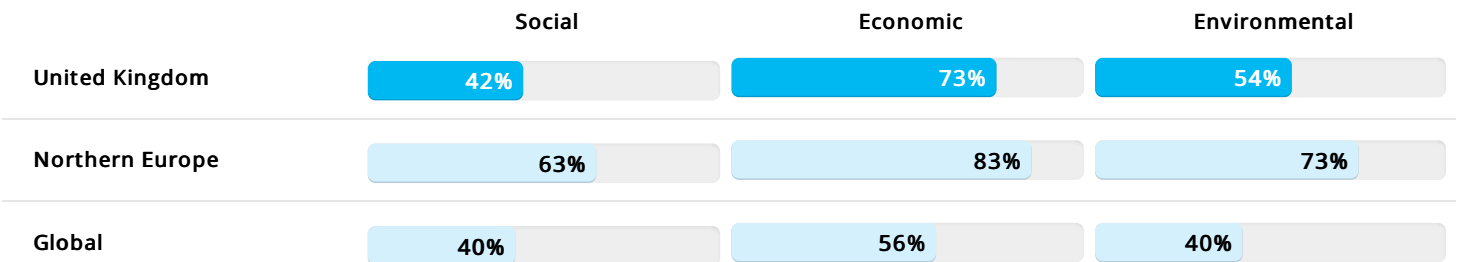

SUMMARY

United Kingdom ranks 52 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 56%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 50% and a data openness subscore of 60%.

United Kingdom scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

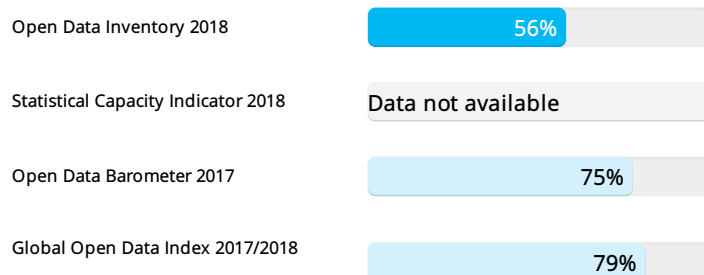
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social statistics.

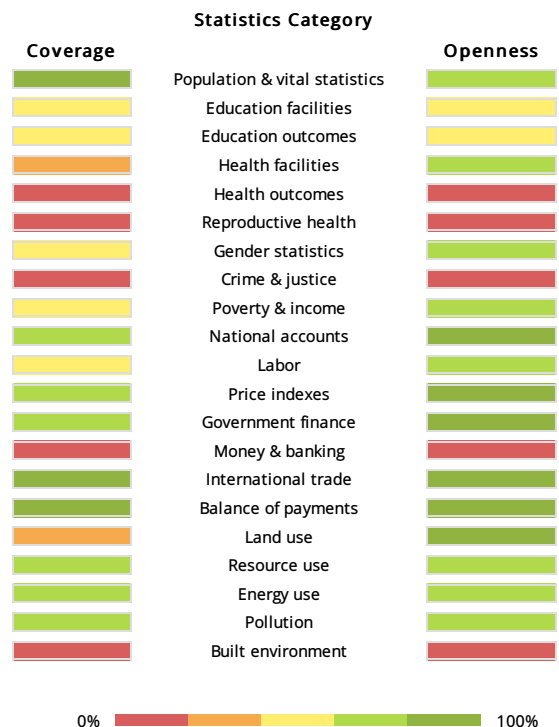
Openness

- Publish more social and environmental data in non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Publish more social metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
