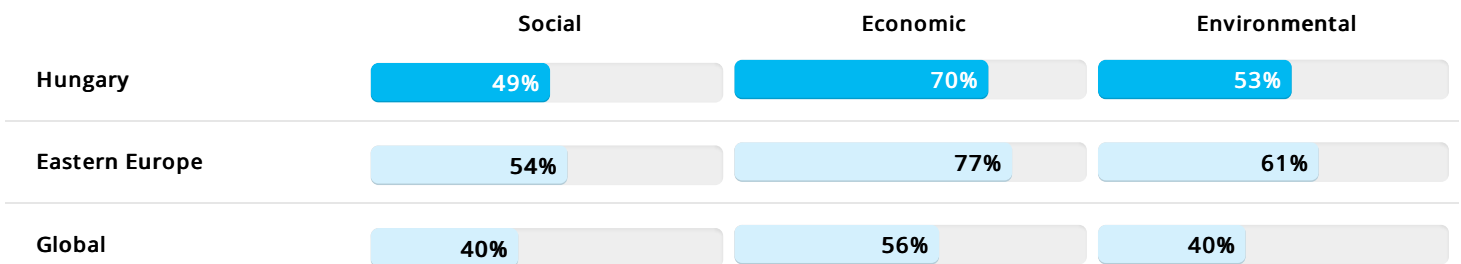

SUMMARY

Hungary ranks 44 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 57%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 53% and a data openness subscore of 61%.

Hungary scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

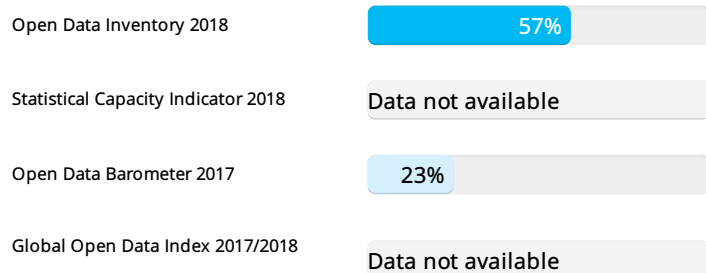
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the second administrative level across all data categories.

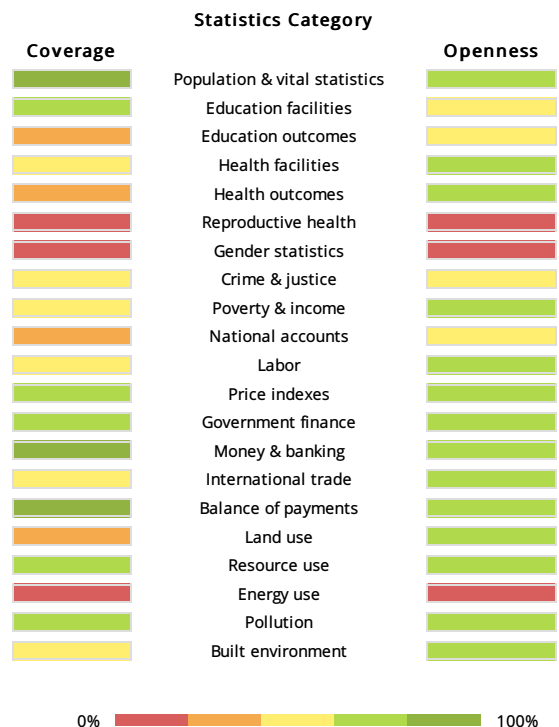
Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Make available download options for social and environmental data to allow users to customize data exports.
