SUMMARY

Indonesia ranks 48 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 56%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 49% and a data openness subscore of 62%.

Indonesia scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

Openness

- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Publish more metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.

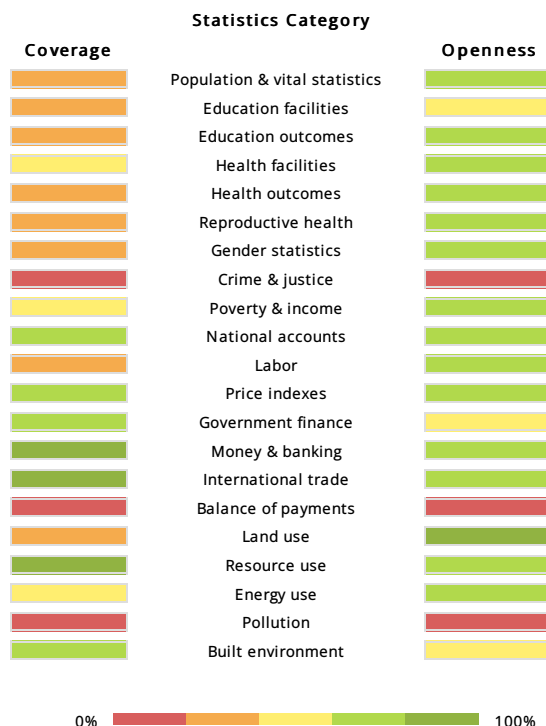
