## SUMMARY

Iceland ranks 57 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 54%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 44% and a data openness subscore of 63%.

Iceland scores lower than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

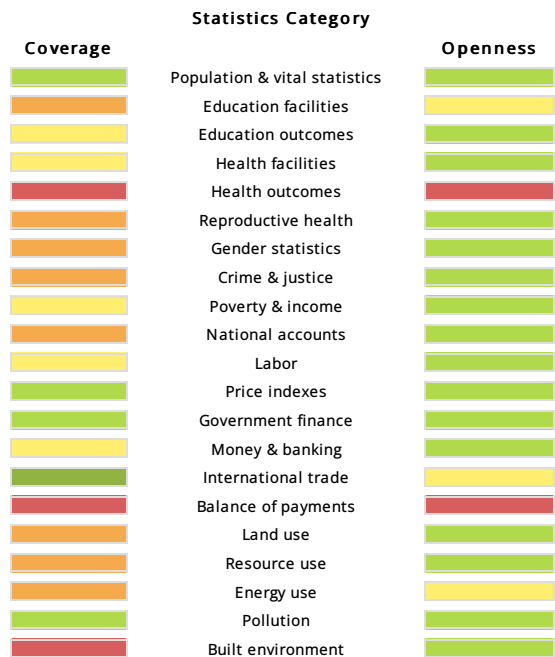
## Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in environmental statistics.

## Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
