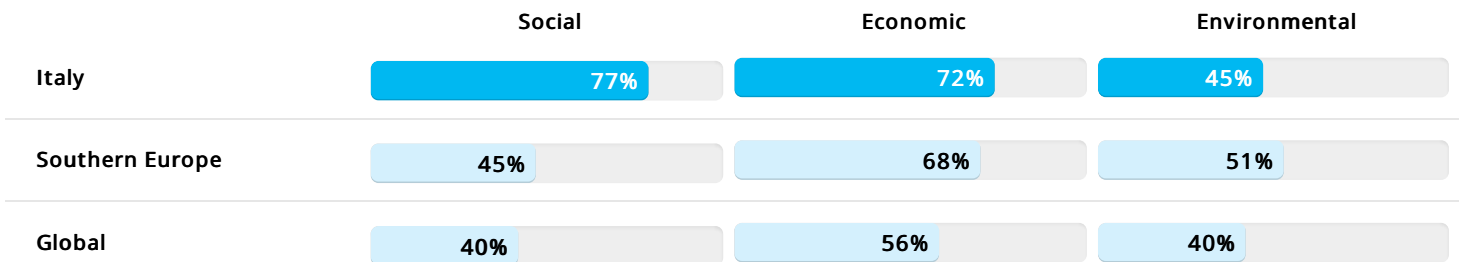

SUMMARY

Italy ranks 30 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 65%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 52% and a data openness subscore of 76%.

Italy scores higher than the regional median for economic and social statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on social statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

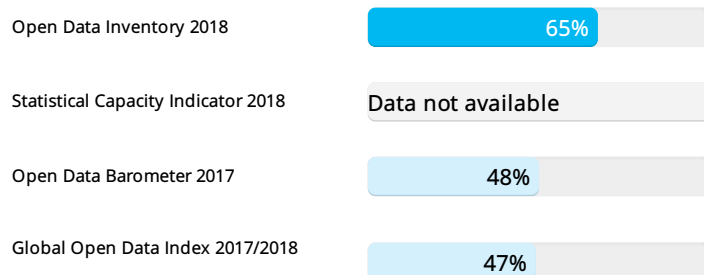
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

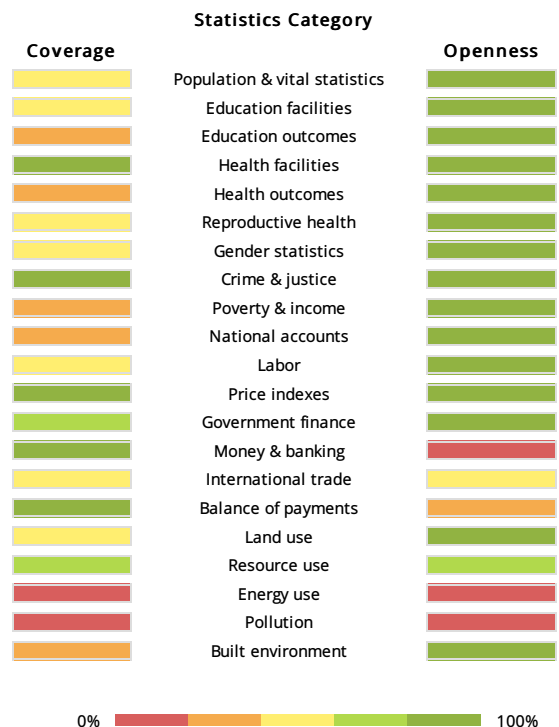
Openness

- Publish more environmental data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Publish more environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
