

SUMMARY


Moldova ranks 2nd in the Open Data Inventory with a total score of 66/100. The total score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 64/100 and a data openness subscore of 68/100.

Moldova scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.


Looking across all 20 data categories, Moldova provides the best coverage on, but not limited to: Money & Banking and International Trade, and the least coverage on: Poverty & Income Statistics and Education Facilities.

In terms of openness, Moldova receives the highest scores on, but not limited to: National Accounts and Labor Statistics, and the lowest scores on, but not limited to: Money & Banking and Balance of Payments.
