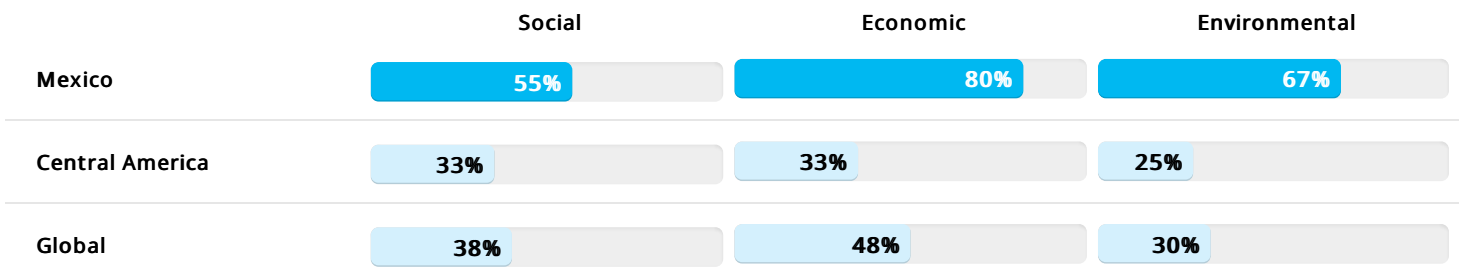

SUMMARY

Mexico ranks 16 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 67%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 53% and a data openness subscore of 80%.

Mexico scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

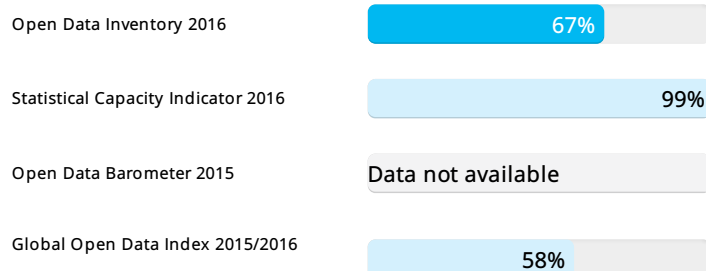
Coverage

- Collect and publish more historical data in social and environmental statistics.

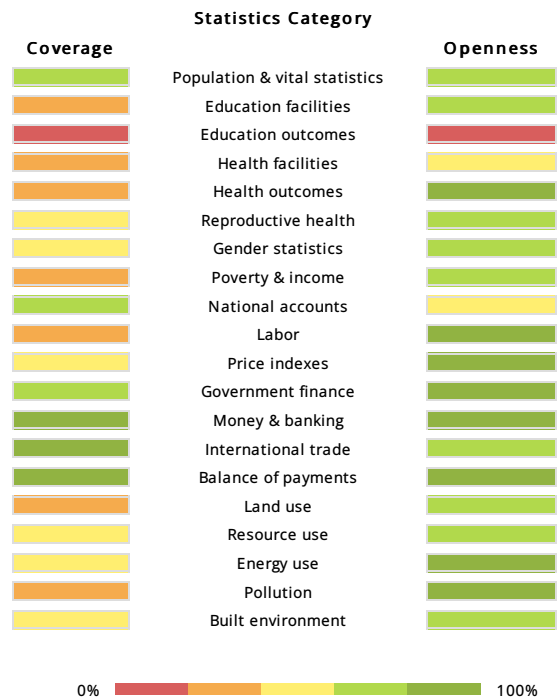
Openness
