SUMMARY

Norway ranks 3 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 80%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 71% and a data openness subscore of 88%.

Norway scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

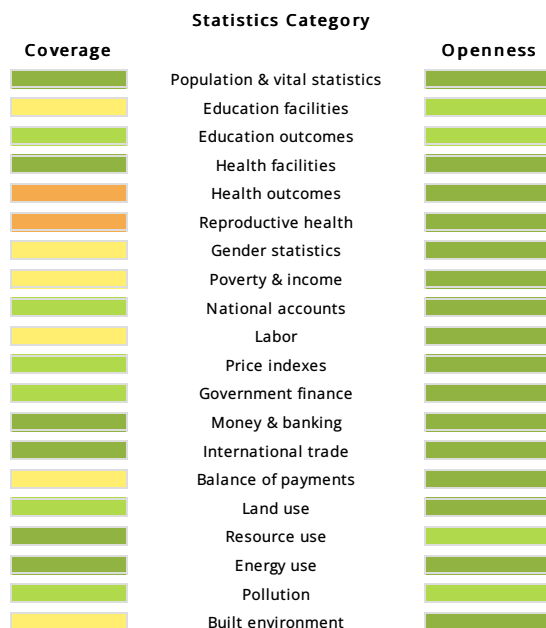
Coverage

- Collect and publish more data disaggregated at the first and second administrative level across all data categories.
- Collect and publish data more disaggregated data on health outcomes and reproductive health.

Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
