SUMMARY

New Zealand ranks 28 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 65%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 54% and a data openness subscore of 75%.

New Zealand scores higher than the regional median for economic statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

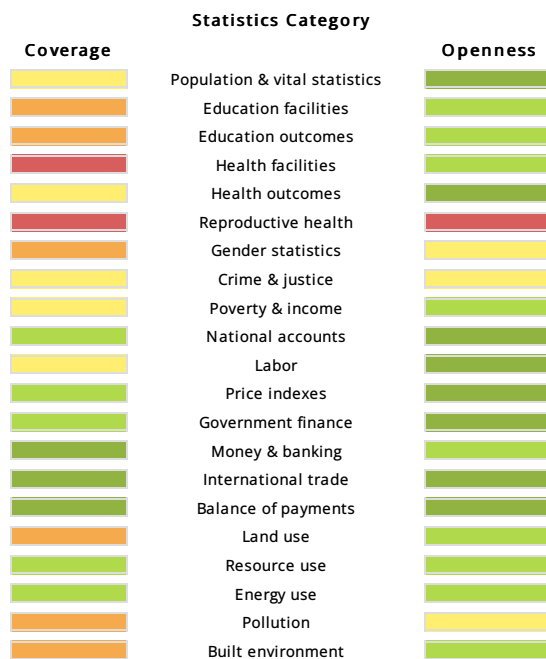
Coverage

- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.
- Collect and publish more historical data in environmental statistics.

Openness

- Publish more economic and environmental metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
- Make available download options for social and environmental data to allow users to customize data exports.
