

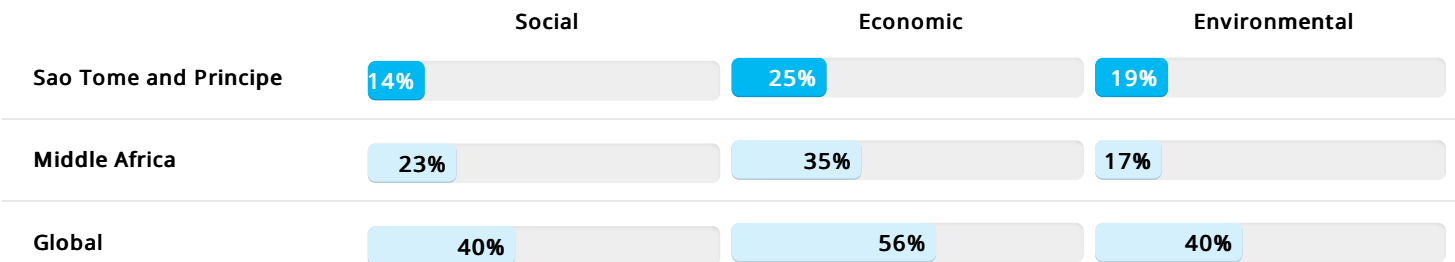

SUMMARY

Sao Tome and Principe ranks 166 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 20%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 15% and a data openness subscore of 24%.

Sao Tome and Principe scores higher than the regional median for environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

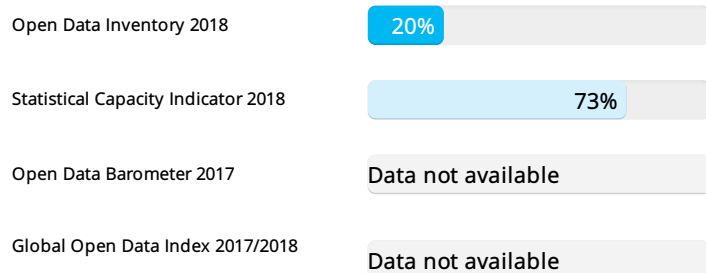
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data across all data categories.
- Collect and publish more recent data across all data categories.

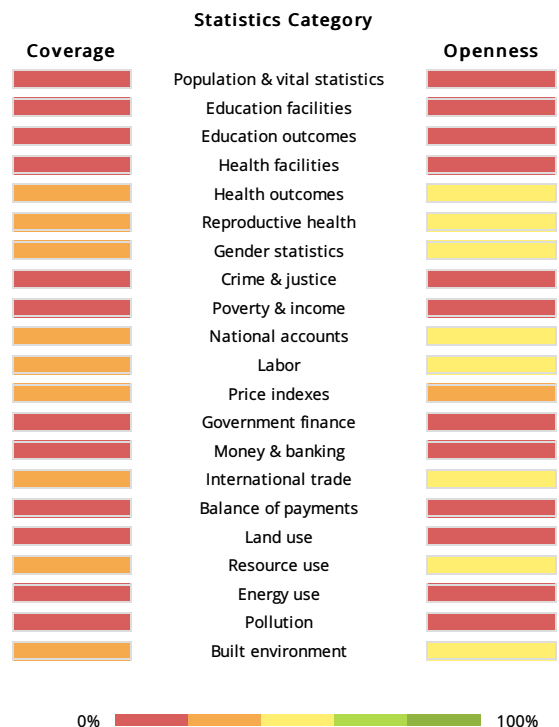
Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more data in machine-readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
