SUMMARY

South Africa ranks 64 in the Open Data Inventory 2018 with an overall score of 51%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 45% and a data openness subscore of 56%.

South Africa scores higher than the regional median across all three major data categories. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on environmental statistics and the lowest levels are on social statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data in social statistics.
- Collect and publish more recent data in social and environmental statistics.

Openness

- Publish more social and environmental data in machine-readable formats such as XLSX, CSV, or JSON.
- Publish more social and economic metadata to accompany data to increase its usefulness.
